

MAHARASHTRA STATE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING BOARD (MSAMB)
Revised Guideline for Booking & Irradiation Processing for Australia at
Irradiation Facility Centre, Vashi Navi Mumbai (02 May, 2017)
For Mango Season 2017

- 1) Booking will be accepted on FIRST COME FIRST SERVE basis, **through ONLINE system only.**
- 2) Booking will be accepted on tote box basis. Minimum 1 Tote box and maximum 200 Tote Box.
 - a. Category A : Small Box of 3.5 Kg – 51 Boxes per tote box;
 - b. Category B: Big Box of 4.2 Kg – 42 boxes per tote box;
 - c. Category C: Half Dozen Box of 2Kg – 102 Boxes per tote box
- 3) Processing charges:
 - a. Category A -
 - i. Irradiation Charges - Rs.110/- per Box
 - ii. Handling Charges - Rs. 4.85/-- per Box
 - iii. Miscellaneous charges - Rs.1.00 Per Kg
 - iv. APEDA Charges - Rs. 20/- per Box
 - b. Category B -
 - i. Irradiation Charges - Rs.130/- per Box
 - ii. Handling Charges - Rs. 4.85/- per Box
 - iii. Miscellaneous charges - Rs.1.00 Per Kg
 - iv. APEDA Charges - Rs. 20/- per Box
 - c. Category C -
 - i. Irradiation Charges - Rs.55/- per Box
 - ii. Handling Charges - Rs. 2.4/- per Box
 - iii. Miscellaneous charges - Rs.1.00 Per Kg
 - iv. APEDA Charges - Rs. 10/- per Box

Note: The volume discount in the irradiation processing charges will be as under:

- a. **Above 50 MTs up to 200 MTs: Discount of Rs. 10 per box for category A & B and Rs. 5 for category C.**
- b. **Above 200 MTs: Discount of Rs. 15 per box for category A & B and Rs. 7.5 for category C.**

- 4) Booking will be started before 5 days of actual date of processing (e.g. Booking of 6th May will start on 1st May).
- 5) Slot shall be booked **ONLINE** only, using online slot booking software of MSAMB (<http://efc.msamb.com>). For slot booking, it is mandatory to register with MSAMB by sending email on msamb@vsnl.com. There are no charges for the exporters for registration with MSAMB.

In case there is an issue regarding online payment while booking of slot, the payment will be accepted by cheque prior to treatment. However, online booking will be compulsory.

In case of cancellation or rejection of slot, the paid amount will be adjusted for next processing.

- 6) Processing will be done Monday to Saturday. Considering the processing for USA and availability of USDA Inspector, the processing for Australia will be done between 6pm to 12 Midnight. In case, processing for mango for USA is not scheduled on any specific day, it will be communicated to the exporters.
- 7) Exporter will ensure to reach the mango vehicle before 6pm on the processing day. No consignment will be accepted after 8pm.
- 8) For issues related to the Shipment, the exporters should approach to MSAMB office at IFC, Vashi.
- 9) Because of any reason, if plant is not available on a particular day or part of the day, processing Fee collected will be carried forward for next available slot/day. The operator/s will not be liable to pay any damages because of any loss, which may occur to the party.
- 10) The exporters are advised to give complete contact details along with contact person to IFC so as to send any information, such as non-availability of the Plant or change of schedule to be intimated to them. Also exporter should send the Proper competent person to address both quarantine officers regarding Certification and any other issue.
- 11) All required documents must be kept ready with the arrival of the material at IFC. The processing will be done on the basis of FIFO. But in case of improper documents, the consignment will be processed, as a last batch, only after compliance of proper documentations. If any exporter repeatedly come with improper documents, his batch will be cancelled or will be scheduled next day, if allocation permits.
- 12) The Required Documents with the Arrived material (in 2 sets) listed below:
 - a. Annexure I & II.
 - b. Invoice.
 - c. Packing List.
 - d. Copy of the application submitted online for phytosanitary certification.
 - e. Importer's Import Permit issued in USA.
 - f. Copy of Import Export Code (IEC Code)

- 13) During processing unforeseen events or circumstances occurs and immediate action is required, Asst. General Manager (Export), MSAMB will take the final decision.
- 14) MSAMB reserves the right to make changes in above guidelines.
